



## GALVANIZED GOURMET - BAATI'S KITCHEN CHRONICLE



Gearing up to entertain loved ones this festive season and feeling puzzled about what to whip up? Don't worry, we've got your back with this super easy, finger-licking recipe that'll dazzle your guests!

#### Stir-fried goat meat:

#### **Ingredients:**

- 1 pound (450g) goat meat, thinly sliced
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1 onion, thinly sliced
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1-inch piece of ginger, grated
- 1 bell pepper, sliced (any color)
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- 1 tablespoon oyster sauce
- 1 tablespoon hoisin sauce
- 1 teaspoon chili flakes to taste
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Fresh cilantro or green onions for garnish (optional)

#### Instructions:

- 1. Marinate the goat meat: In a bowl, combine the sliced goat meat with a bit of salt, pepper, and a ta blespoon of soy sauce. Let it marinate for at least 15-20 minutes.
- 2. Heat a large skillet or wok over medium-high heat. Add the vegetable oil.
- 3. Once the oil is hot, add the marinated goat meat. Stir-fry for 5-6 minutes or until the meat is browned and cooked through. Remove the meat from the skillet and set it aside.
- 4. In the same skillet, add a bit more oil if needed. Sauté the sliced onions until they become translucent.



- 5. Add the minced garlic and grated ginger to the skillet. Cook for another minute until fragrant.
- 6. Toss in the sliced bell pepper and stir-fry for a couple of minutes until it starts to soften.
- 7. Return the cooked goat meat to the skillet and mix it with the vegetables.
- 8. In a small bowl, mix together the remaining soy sauce, oyster sauce, hoisin sauce, and chili flakes. Pour this sauce over the goat meat and vegetables. Stir everything together to coat evenly.
- 9. Cook for an additional 2-3 minutes, allowing the flavors to blend and the sauce to slightly thicken.
- 10.Taste and adjust seasoning with salt, pepper, or more chili flakes if desired.
- 11. Garnish with fresh cilantro or green onions if you like, then serve your delicious stir-fried goat meat over rice or with your favorite side dishes.

  Enjoy your flavorful and tender stir-fried goat meat!

Adjust the seasonings and spice levels according to your preference.


