With UGX 230,000 for a 1 year UVTAB/DIT certification (inclusive of materials) and UGX 330,000 for National Certificate Craft 1 & 2 (2 year programs). Admission to the Tororo campus is free, making it one of the most accessible training opportunities in the region.

Beyond skills training, the institute aims to unlock livelihoods and strengthen communities by equipping young people with practical capabilities that can transform their futures.

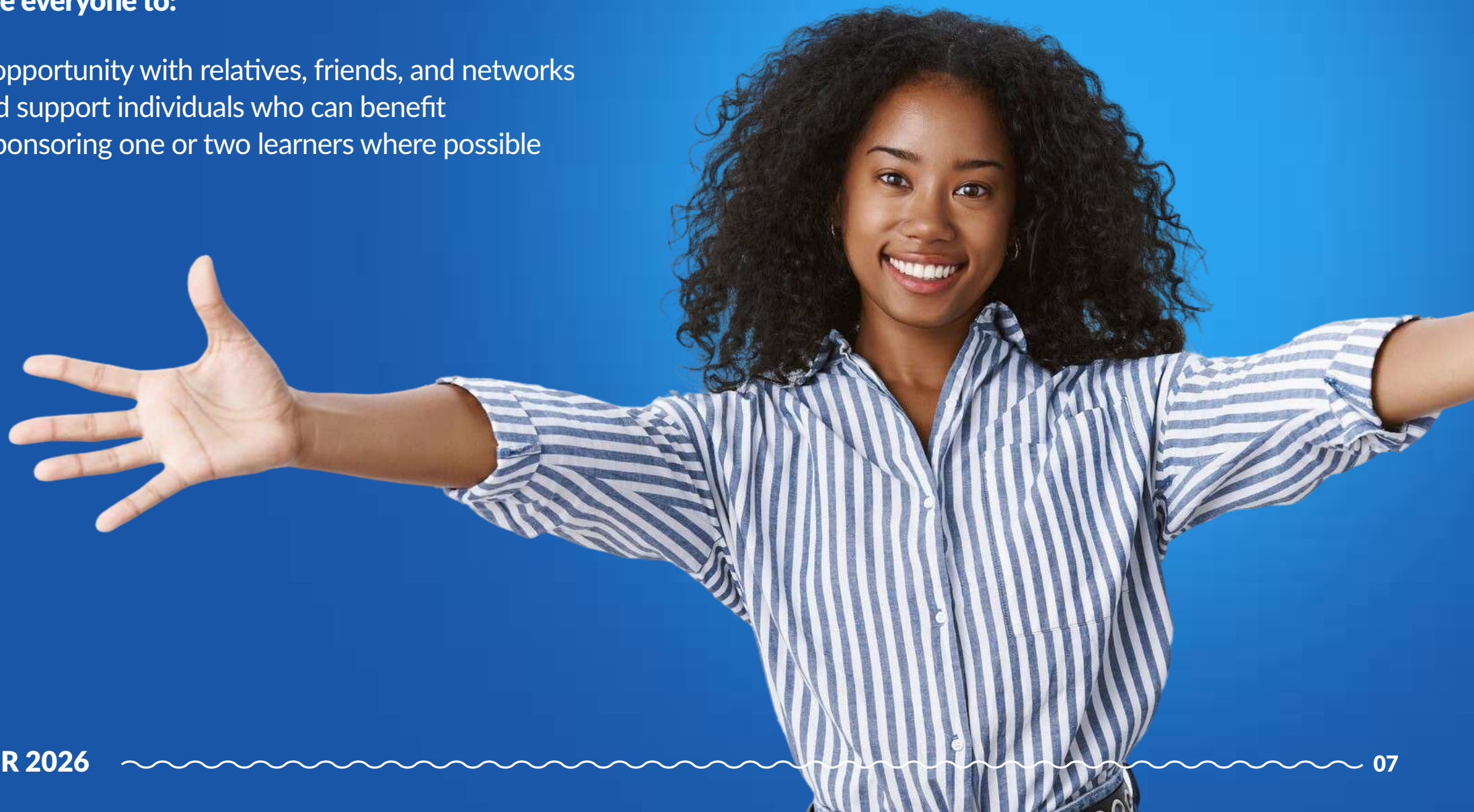
